### PARENTAL NOTIFICATIONS

The Yolo County Board of Education and the Yolo County Office of Education recognize that notifications are essential to effective communication between the school and the home. The Yolo County Superintendent of Schools or designee shall send students and parents/guardians all notifications required by law, including notifications about their legal rights, and any other notifications he/she believes will promote parental understanding and involvement.

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The County Superintendent or designee shall ensure that notifications which must be sent at the beginning of each academic year include a request that the parent/guardian sign the notice and return it to the school. (Education Code 48981, 48982)

Notifications to parents/guardians shall be written both in English and in the family's primary language when so required by law. Whenever an employee learns that a student's parent/guardian is for any reason unable to understand the County Office's printed notifications, the site administrator or designee shall work with the parent/guardian to establish other appropriate means of communication.
