**College and Career Readiness**

- Hecho A Mano Academy is finishing up. Last day will be 7/27.
- 12 teachers from CTE programs throughout Yolo County are participating in teacher externships.
- Adult Education Literacy and HiSET are operating throughout the summer at the Yolo Day Reporting Center and Monroe Detention Center. We had 2 students test and pass the HiSET in Spanish. This is a huge accomplishment as there is no written record of a student in Monroe taking and passing the HiSET in Spanish in the past. (The **HiSET** exam gives out-of-school youth and adults the best opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and earn a state-issued high school equivalency)
- Developing the charter petition in partnership with Student Services

**Curriculum and Instructional Services**

- K-12 Administrator Breakfast July 27 flyer attached
- July 5- July 27 - **Project SOLAR Summer Environmental Science & Energy Academy** will be held in West Sacramento at the Bryte Career & College Center (in partnership with Woodland Community College, Washington USD, City of West Sacramento and Center for Land-Based Learning). High school students attend for free and earn 3 units of community college credits. Thanks to support from the City of West Sacramento, 16 of the students in the class will participate in paid Growing Green Internship program and earning an additional unit of credit.
- **Highlight:** Last week's field trip to new **Sunpower** R&D in Davis, home to the "Greenbotics" robot that cleans the solar panels using only a small amount of water. Students met the young engineers and learned about how the robot was developed and saw a demonstration. Research at the facility includes how to grow crops under the solar panels which was a concern when Yolo County put in the panels at **Grasslands Regional Park**. Students then toured the solar installation at Grasslands, visited the hedgerow planted at the park last spring by Davis High School students and were treated to a flying demonstration by the Sacramento Valley Soaring Society.

**Early Childhood Services**

- For the month of July, on July 11, the Region 9 TTA person came to Lincoln and provided training on how to create meaningful family partnership goals with families and we came in agreement on how to track those goals to get reliable data. We also went over the new ERSEA Monthly monitoring tool we created.
- For August- we have our pre-service August 1-15. The calendar is attached.

## SELPA

- A fiscal ad hoc committee for the SELPA will begin meeting in August to make recommendations to the Superintendents' Council to revise the SELPA's AB 602 Allocation Plan and create a policy to govern the disbursement of monies earmarked for educationally related mental health.
- SELPA professional development workshops begin in August. The major areas of focus this year are alternative dispute resolution (i.e., communication skills and IEP facilitation skills), writing measurable baselines and Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals, and promoting evidence-based instructional practices.

## Student Services

- **Summer School at Cesar Chavez**  
We had 11 student enrolled and completed Session 1 with 87% attendance. Students earned 3 credits in English
- **Dan Jacobs ESY**  
Students are working collaboratively on Thematic units. Teachers are implementing fun and innovative curriculum to keep interest during the summer and hot days. Long term substitutes and Para-educators were trained and have integrated into the probation team seamlessly.
- **PBIS-** Working on setting a "Kick-Off" Date. Should be after labor Day. Awaiting new staff hires and probation staff hires.
- **1 graduate** from Dan Jacobs on July 17<sup>th</sup>. He is currently working on enrollment into community college with Probation Interns. 1<sup>st</sup> Graduate under WASC accreditation.
- **2 youth** currently enrolled in **post-graduate courses**. 1 youth will finish first semester of Junior college at the end of July.
- **A 6 year WASC Accreditation** was given to Cesar Chavez. A **3 year Accreditation** was given to Dan Jacobs School.
