

#### **Governor's Budget Proposal for 2017-18**

#### **Highlights**

- ⇒ Department of Finance (DOF) reports that State Revenues are starting to lag expectations
- ⇒ Cost of Living is proposed at 1.48%, which applies to all State funded programs
- ⇒ On-Going funding for County Office LCAP work has *not* been included, although there is a financial burden to provide guidance and oversight
- ⇒ One-time funding (offsetting prior year mandate reimbursement claims) is proposed at \$48 per ADA (down from \$214)
- ⇒ No proposed changes to SELPA structure in California at this time
- ⇒ Federal Program funding uncertain at this time





### **Governor's Budget Proposal for 2017-18**

Translation of the Governor's Budget Proposal and impacts on YCOE:

- $\Rightarrow$  Cost of Living increase = +\$35,977 (to LCFF funding)
- ⇒ End of one-time LCAP funding =-\$75,000
- ⇒ One-time mandate payment funding decrease= -\$29,000
- ⇒ Although not directly part of the budget, STRS and PERS rates have recently increased as follows:
  - ⇒ Increased cost of STRS across all YCOE programs = \$217,681
  - ⇒ Increased cost of PERS across all YCOE programs = \$137,217
