What is a Youth Master Plan?

A roadmap that guides community stakeholders in supporting our youth. It is a document, which helps to define a vision for the future based on impute from the stakeholders and youth. It seeks to ensure accountability and sustainability over time.

Key Elements of Youth Master Plan

1. Engage key stakeholders throughout the community
2. Establish and promote a shared vision for youth.
3. Assess needs and design comprehensive strategies
4. Create a framework for shared accountability
5. Coordinate city, school, and other community efforts
6. Provide direct link between plan goals and objectives to the City General Plan, the School District, Strategic Plan, and the Community College Strategic Plan

The future of our youth depends on actions, or lack thereof, which are taking place today.
