# LEA PLAN COMPONENTS

- Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) - multiple stakeholders develop goals, plan actions and leverage resources to improve student outcomes
- Consolidated Application – documentation of participation in programs and assurances that YCCA will comply with legal requirements of federal programs
- Federal Addendum – an LCAP supplement, this document ensures that YCCA meet the LEA Plan provisions of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)
- Resolution of LEA Plan Approval – documentation that outlines the LCAP process and final approval by the YCCA governing body (superintendent).

# LCAP Goals

- Goal 1 – Provide all students with classroom instruction and curriculum that promote college and career readiness.  
~ project-based learning ~ integration of academics and career technical education ~ intervention support
- Goal 2 – Support students in creating personalized outcomes and building 21<sup>st</sup> century skills.  
~ social-emotional well-being ~ career exploration and planning ~ individual learning plans ~ transitions
- Goal 3 – Ensure that all students have a safe, inclusive, and clean environment, in which to learn and thrive, and engage families in this effort.  
~ positive behavior intervention support (PBIS) ~ counseling services ~ multi-tiered systems of support

# LEA PLAN PROCESS

- Multiple stakeholders were involved with the development of the LCAP throughout the 18-19 school year.
- Administration gathered the data to complete the ConApp and Federal Addendum in the spring of 2019.
- The LCAP, ConApp, and Federal Addendum were presented to the YCCA Executive Board for information and action. The Board recommended to the Governing Board or Superintendent Lewis to approve each of the LEA Plan components at a special Executive Board Meeting held June 18.
- Superintendent Lewis reviewed and approved the YCCA LEA Plan. This was documented through the signed Resolution# 18-19/01 on June 28, 2019.
