RE: ANNUAL NOTIFICATION OF EXPECTED PESTICIDES

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 was signed into law in September 2000 and requires that all schools provide parents/guardians of students and staff with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites. The notification will identify the active ingredient or ingredients in each pesticide product and will include the Internet address (http://www.cdpr.ca.gov) for further information on pesticides and their alternatives.

Below is a list of chemicals that could be used at our school sites. If the list should change, you will receive an updated list.
