



TARGET AREAS OF YOLO COUNTY TRANSITION AGE YOUTH WORK



Work-Ready Certificate A reflective and experiential learning opportunity for TAY to gain skills, confidence, and a certificate demonstrating that they are ready for the world of work.



Coordination of Services Community and school-based partners working together to foster an interconnected systems framework to increase the available services across the school



day.

Communication Strategy A centralized space for communication of resources, events and/or opportunities for TAY in Yolo County.

Whole Family Education Building family and student capacity to be literate in reading, finance, and how to access resources.



Co-Navigators Network School counselors and community conavigators with skillsets and resources to support TAY in education/career mapping, resource navigation, and success planning.

Workgroup Tasks

The 5 W's

What is the area of focus? Are there identified champions?

Who and which organizations are present in this work?

Why is this area of focus important to the lives of Transition Age Youth, families, and the larger community?

Where do we hope this work can take us? How might this work transform systems and the larger community?

When will the first meeting after the TAY Summit be? Is there a cadence of meeting times and duration? Are there location requests?

Collective Impact



SMARTIE Goal

Answers to these questions will help to ensure that goals are **SMARTIE**:

Specific: Does each goal clearly state what is to be accomplished? Where appropriate, does it specify where and by whom activities should be carried out?

Measurable: Does each goal refer to a measurable outcome? Does it set a standard that will allow the team to know whether or not the goal has been met?

Attainable/Ambitious: Does the goal seem reachable given where things are now? At the same time, is it challenging enough that success would mean significant progress?

Relevant: Will attaining this goal make a difference in the quality of young people's lives? Is the goal aligned with other goals?

Time-bound: Has a timeframe been established for achieving the goal? Have shorter-term benchmarks been set so progress can be monitored along the way?

Inclusive: Does this goal invite traditionally excluded individuals to make decisions and contribute in a way that shares power?

Equitable: Does this goal include an element of fairness or justice that seeks to address systemic injustice, inequity, or oppression?
