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Contests for Students

The primary goals of the schools and the needs and interests of pupils are the basic considerations.

The Criteria for Selection of Educational Contests are:

- 1. One that supplements and compliments the regular school program.
- 2. One that is beneficial to youth in educational, civic, social, or cultural development.
- 3. One whose subject is not commercial or sectarian. It must emphasize high moral standards, good citizenship, and intellectual performance.
- 4. One from which no contestant should be excluded because of race or ethnicity, color, ancestry, sex, sexual orientation, nationality, national origin, immigration status, religion, physical or mental disability, gender, gender identity, gender expression, or payment of entry fee.
- 5. One which does not place an undue burden on students, teachers, or the Yolo County Office of Education, nor which require frequent or lengthy absence of participants.

The Yolo County Superintendent of Schools or designee will authorize participation based on the criteria.
