County Community Day School Vs. Community School


County Community Day School

Community day schools are schools for students who have been expelled from school or who have had problems with attendance or behavior.

Full-Service Community School (Community)

A community school is a public school that can serve prekindergarten through grade twelve and has community partnerships that support improved academic outcomes, whole-child engagement, and family development.

Student Population

In the 2022-2023

- Total enrollment of 39 students.
- 32 were unduplicated pupils (82.05%),
- 13 students were identified as experiencing housing instability (33.3%)
- 12 students (30.8%) were identified as having disabilities (DataQuest).

In the 2023-24 school year

- Enrollment increased to 65 students.

- Annual Sustainability Plan Updates, starting in Year 2
- Participation in professional development activities provided by the CDE, the State Transformative Assistance Center and Regional Technical Assistance Centers.

June–July 2024	Grant Award Notification Letters Released
July 1, 2024	Project Term Begins
August 2024	Disbursement of Funds
June 30, 2029	All Funds Must be Expended
